## Camporee Events

- **Adult Leader Training**

There should be some type of adult leader training offered on Saturday morning. All training course offered will be coordinated with the District Training Committee. Training courses to be offered will be announced at future Roundtable Meetings and posted on the District Website.

- **Iron Chef Competition**

Each troop will be allowed to enter an "Iron Chef" team that will prepare an entrée and a dessert using an ingredient supplied by the Camporee staff. There will be one secret ingredient for an entrée and one for a dessert.

This event will be held around the Big House Pavilion and all cooking must be done in a designated area. Each team may use any equipment or condiments that they bring with them. To make things a little more challenging, use of propane stoves will not be allowed and all cooking must be done over an open fire or with charcoal.

All judging will be based on appearance, taste and presentation.

## **Camporee Events**

- **Patrol Cooking Competitions**

Several different entrée and dessert categories will be created for patrol cooking competitions. Each competition category will have a limit of 6-8 patrols depending on event participation. All entrée & dessert categories will be announced at future Roundtable meetings and also posted on the District Websites. Once the categories are posted on the Website, troops and patrol can sign-up for a specific category by contacting the Camporee chairman. Only one patrol per troop may sign-up for a particular entrée or dessert category. Special adult categories will also be established.

All cooking must be done in a troop/patrol cooking area established in the activity field. This will allow other Camporee participants the opportunity to observe and learn from other units. No ground fires are allowed in the activity field.

All judging will be held late in the afternoon around 4-5:00 pm. All patrol entries must include a written recipe listing all ingredients which will be used to create a Camporee Recipe book. Judging will be based on appearance, taste and presentation.

- **Judging**

We all know that Scoutmasters like to eat, so unit leaders are welcome to volunteer and serve as a Judge. To keep judging impartial, unit leaders will only judge categories which do not have a patrol from their troop.

- **Apalachee District Pot-Luck Dinner**

Once all cooking is done & the judging is in progress, it is time for everyone to eat. All Camporee participants will have the opportunity to go around the activity field to sample the various entrée and desserts prepared by the participating troops & patrols. Having several different entrée and dessert categories will help insure there is a variety of things sample. Each troop or patrol should be prepared to offer samples to other participants.

- **Awards Campfire**

An evening campfire program will be planned. Troops and patrols asked to participate by planning a skit. Awards will also be presented for the best entries in the Iron Chef competition and for all patrol cook-off categories.

Information concerning patrol cooking categories & signed-up patrols will be posted on the website and will be updated on a regular basis.
