

Outdoorsman Requirements for Webelos

1. With your family or Webelos den, help plan and take part in an evening outdoor activity that includes a campfire.
 - Patrol need to have skit or song for campfire on Saturday night 11/11/2006.
2. With your parent or guardian, take part in a Webelos den overnight campout or a family campout. Sleep in a tent that you have helped pitch.
 - Camp at Fort Yargo on 11/10/2006 or 11/11/2006
3. Discuss with your Webelos den leader the things that you need to take on a hike. Go on one 3-mile hike with your Webelos den. During a Webelos den meeting, discuss how to follow the Leave No Trace Front country Guidelines during outdoor activities (See page 72.)
 - Saturday 11/11/2006 at 10am meet at Picnic Shelter be ready for 3-mile hike and bring one trash bag per patrol.

4. Discuss with your Webelos den leader the rules of outdoor fire safety. Using these rules, show how to build a safe fire and put it out.

- All patrols need to work on this Friday or Saturday on down time.

5. With your accompanying adult on a campout or outdoor activity, assist in preparing, cooking, and cleanup for one of your den's meals. Tell why it is important for each den member to share in meal preparation and cleanup, and explain the importance of eating together.

6. Demonstrate how to whip and fuse the ends of a rope.

- Saturday 11/11/2006 at 2 pm meet at Picnic Shelter be ready!
- All Patrols need to work on Square Knot, Taut-line Hitch, Clove Hitch, Two Half Hitches, Bowline and Sheet Bend. All Knots are in your Webelos handbook pages 350 and 351.
- Rope will give out at October pack meeting.
- All Patrols need to have rope and 5 to 6 foot pole (broom handle) will work.
