Who May Attend?

To attend Wood Badge, Scouters must:

1. Be registered members of the Boy Scouts of America.
2. Have not previously completed a 21st Century Wood Badge course.
3. Have completed the basic training courses for their Scouting position.¹
4. Have completed the outdoor skills training program appropriate to their Scouting positions.²
5. Be capable of functioning safely in an outdoor environment.

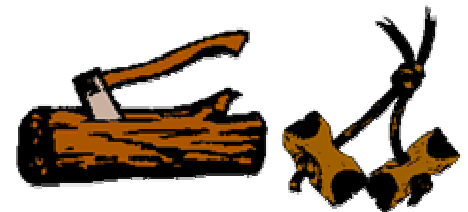
- Introduction to Outdoor Leader skills (required for Scoutmasters, assistant Scoutmasters, and all Varsity Coaches and assistants)
- All participants are encouraged to complete the Introduction to Outdoor Leader skills training before attending a Wood Badge course. Encouraged, but not required.

What will be required of me as a participant?

- Complete, proper BSA Field uniform for your position
- Full participation at all training sessions during two FULL three-day weekends (no makeup sessions)
- A great Scouting attitude!

Other Information

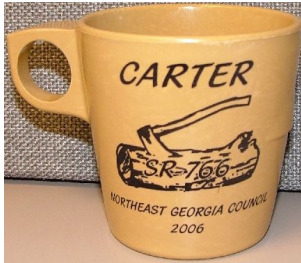
- All participants must present a completed BSA Medical Form # 34605 upon arrival.
- Registration is available to all qualified Scouters (see column to the left). Confirmation letters are sent in late 2009.
- The last two courses filled up very early— signing up now with your \$50 deposit holds your spot.
- You may submit your full fee now, or a \$50 deposit now & the balance prior to the beginning of the course.
- To qualify for the "Early Bird" discounted fee, all fees must be received in the Council Service Center by March 12, 2010.

Mugs are available for Pre-order. These are durable mugs that participants find very useful during the course and cherish for years to come. Pre-order yours upon registration, since we can't order extras!

Mugs are only \$12 and will be etched with the council name, year, Wood Badge logo, your name or nickname and the year. Don't miss out!

Other Wood Badge Information:

- Successful participation includes attendance at all sessions at for 2 Friday morning through late Sunday weekends. You should plan to take two Fridays off from work.
- You will be camping. Plan to bring sleeping bags, clothing & raingear appropriate to April and May.
- Confirmation letters will be mailed late 2009.

Cost:

- **\$50 Deposit to hold your spot** (applicable to course fee) Nonrefundable unless course is cancelled.
- **Early Bird Course Fee: \$210** : covers program & training materials, all food for the first weekend only, 1 participant T-shirt and cap, and (upon completion of training program) Wood Badge presentation kit.
- **Additional T-shirts** must be preordered and paid for by March 12, 2010.
- T-shirts are available only in Men's sizes, M thru XXXL.
- **\$12: Wood Badge Mug** with our council name, year, Wood Badge Logo, your name and course number. Most people get one of these, but it's up to you.
